This funding will be used to

- support the staff capacity building in the areas of reading and writing. Staff will be supported through the school's Collegial Engagement Framework as they continue to embed agreed teaching practices.

Leading to the achievement of,

- 50% students achieving an 'A' or 'B' in English
- 80% students achieving a C or higher in English
- 55% students achieving in the Upper Two Bands Year 3 Naplan Reading
- 45% students achieving in the Upper Two Bands Year 5 Naplan Reading

Our initiatives include

- Participation in a three year Regional Project – Leading Learning Collaborative utilising Sharratt's 14 parameters as a framework for school improvement.
- Continue appointment of a Pedagogy Coach to support the school's Collegial Engagement Framework.
- Maintain professional learning teams as a strategy to deepen teacher knowledge and understanding of the Australian Curriculum.
- Appoint an Early Years Partnership Coordinator to enhance successful transitions for Prep students from local early learning centres.
- Identify, purchase and utilise age appropriate classroom resources.
- Appoint a Speech Language Pathologist to work within the Response to Intervention team to build staff capability in oral language.
- Continue increase to school's Guidance Officer allocation to assist with support and intervention programs for identified students.


